

UNIVERSITY RESERVE TRAINING PROGRAMME (URTP) COMMISSIONING PARADE ON 12 DECEMBER 2012 AT SCHOOL OF ARMOUR IN (TEMPE) BLOEMFONTEIN

The implementation of the University Reserve Training Programme (URTP) by the South African Army (SA Army) commenced with a pilot programme in the Free State in collaboration with the University of the Free State and the Central University of Technology.

During 2011, one hundred and twenty students from these universities were assessed and sixty four members were selected for military training. In January 2012, fifty six members of this group completed their Basic Military Training and on 10 December 2012 fifty four members completed their Officer Formative Training at the De Brug training area.

The completion of the Officer Formative Training course by the SA Army is the achievement of an important milestone not only for the SA Army but also for Defence Reserves and the South African National Defence Force (SANDF)."

Training success rate: 84, 4%.

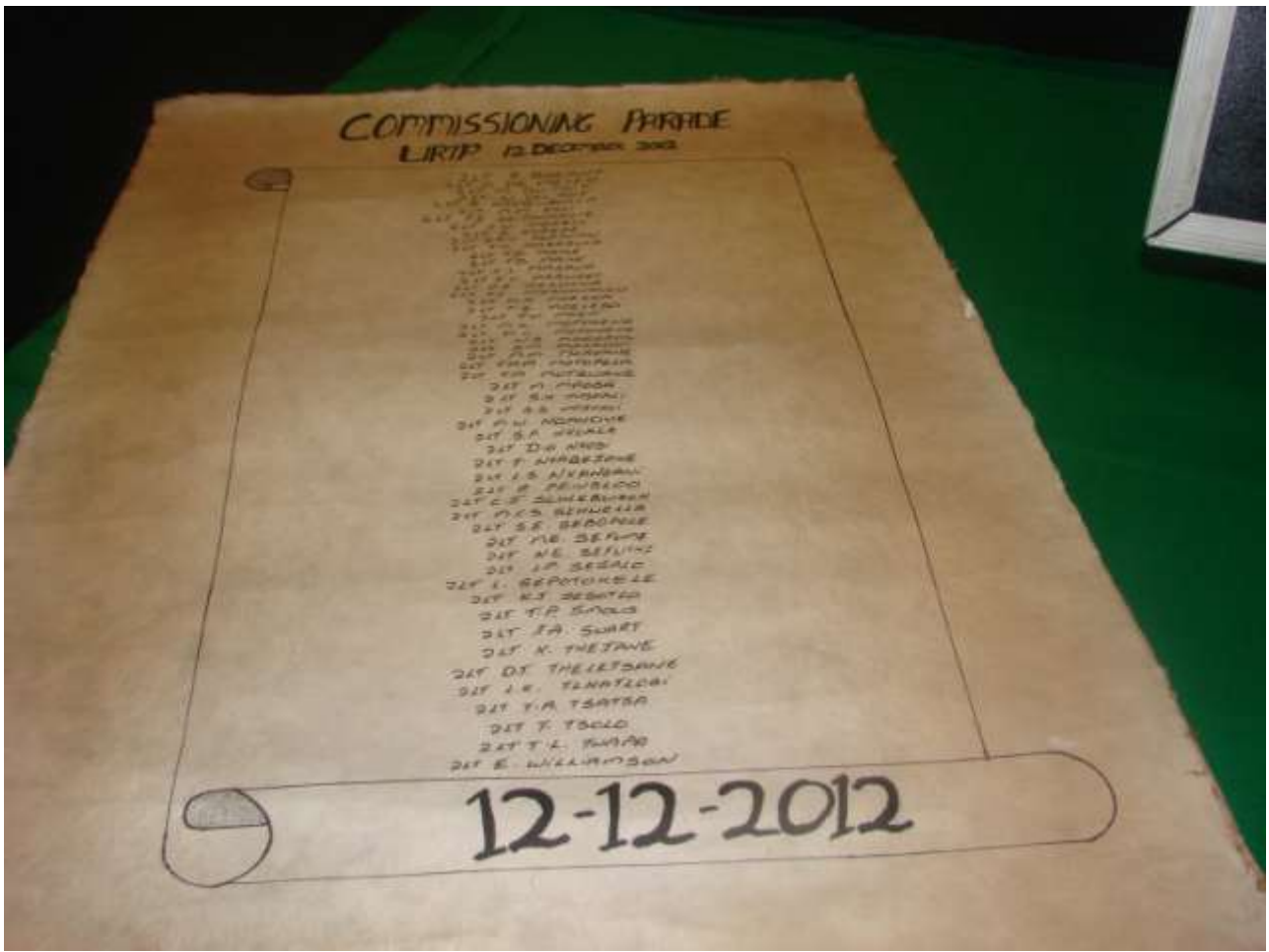
