Students studying through UNISA who are able to attend the recruitment campaign at any of the above Universities and who will be able to attend the training in Gauteng, will also be invited to apply.

When will the recruitment take place?

During March 2013.

When will the training commence?

During June/July University vacation.

Who may apply?

Registered students studying at the above Universities who have successfully completed their first year of study may apply.

How to apply?

Application forms will be made available on the campuses during the March recruitment period.
