



THE UNIVERSITY RESERVE TRAINING PROGRAMME (URTP): ANNOUNCEMENT ON THE ROLL-OUT OF THE URTP: UNIVERSITY OF THE WITWATERSRAND (WITS)

The SA Army, the SA Military Health Service and the Logistics Division have announced their intention to recruit registered students from the University of the Witwatersrand. The selected students will receive military training on a part-time basis in accordance with the concept of the URTP.

As at other universities, recruitment will take place in terms of the skills requirement of the abovementioned Services and Division which will include the following fields of study:

- Economics and Finance
- Information and Communication Technology
- Health Sciences including Medicine, Dental, Pharmacy, Social work and Psychology
- Engineering and the Built Environment
- Humanities

Students interested in serving in the following Formations of the SA Army are also invited to attend the recruitment campaign on the campus:

- Intelligence
- Signals
