



THE UNIVERSITY RESERVE TRAINING PROGRAMME (URTP) EXTENDED TO THE POTCHEFSTROOM CAMPUS OF THE NORTH WEST UNIVERSITY (NWU)

By 4 February the 2013 academic year will be in full swing on most of the campuses of South African universities.

On their return to campus, students of the NWU (Potchefstroom campus) will notice a huge billboard advertising the URTP. It is strategically placed between the “Amfi”, the “SS” and Lover’s Lane – a very busy passage used by the academic staff and students.

During the month of February an URTP awareness campaign will take place on the campus. The display of the billboard will be followed by posters on notice boards, distribution of flyers and other marketing material, adverts over PUK FM and other forms of publicity with the objective of making students aware of the challenging programme of part-time military training offered by the SA National Defence Force to selected students.

The campaign will culminate on 11 March when actual recruitment for the URTP by the SA Army, the SA Military Health Service and the Logistics Division will take place. Students interested in the URTP will be invited to attend a presentation made by the above mentioned Services and Division. The presentations will take place in “Die Galery” (Next to the Ferdinand Postma Library) from 13h00 – 14h00 and again from 14h30 – 15h30.

The awareness and recruitment campaign is executed in close collaboration with the Career Centre and Career Consultants of the Institutional Office of the NWU.
