6 Medical Battalion Group was formed on 01 July 1983 with the purpose of providing operational medical support to the mobile conventional forces. During 1994 with the rationalization of military units, 2 Medical Battalion Group, 5 Medical Battalion Group and 6 Medical Battalion Group amalgamated and became 6 Medical Battalion Group.

The unit Force Structure consists of the following sub-units:

- b. Reserve Force Wing. (ResF)
- c. Medical Task Group 1. (ResF)
- d. Medical Task Group 2. (ResF)
- e. Clinical Wing. (ResF)
- f. Force Preparation. (ResF)
- g. Force Support. (ResF)

6 Medical Battalion Group is situated in Kempton Park and has the entire Gauteng, Limpopo, parts of Mpumalanga and parts of North West within its area of responsibility.
